Choose things from the Huguenot Museum that you would like to include in your own museum.

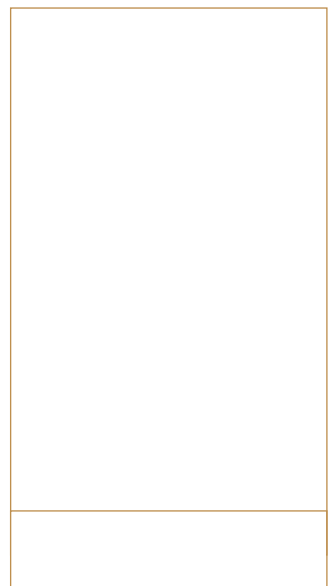
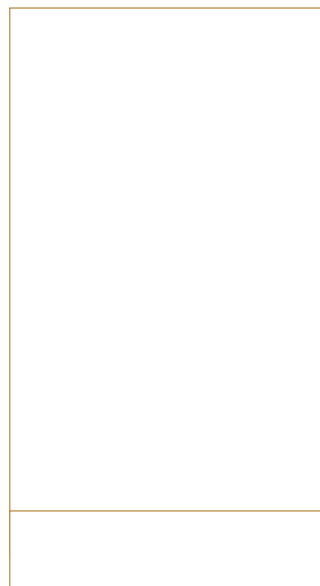
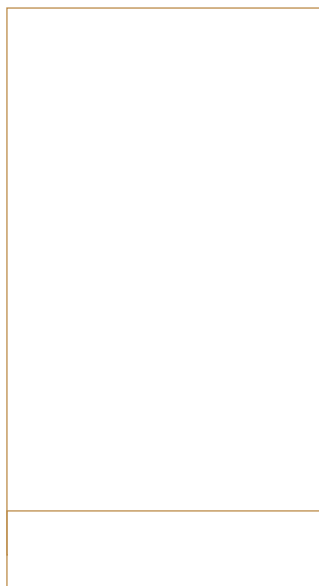
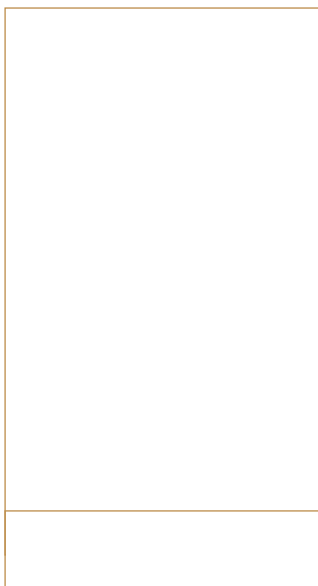
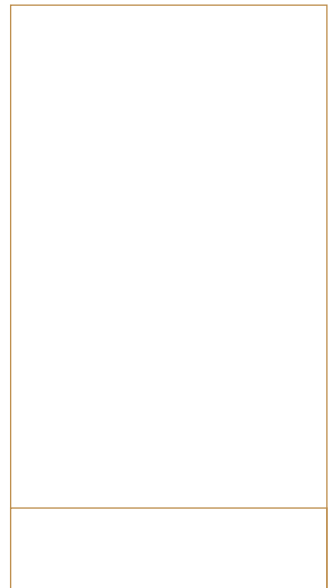
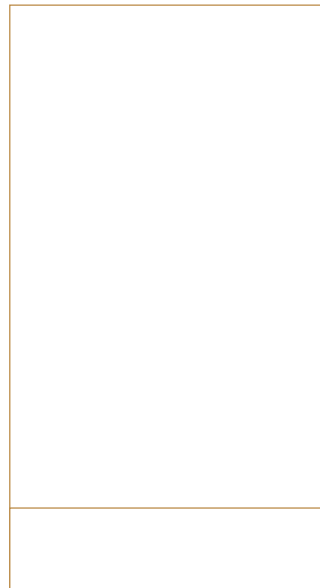
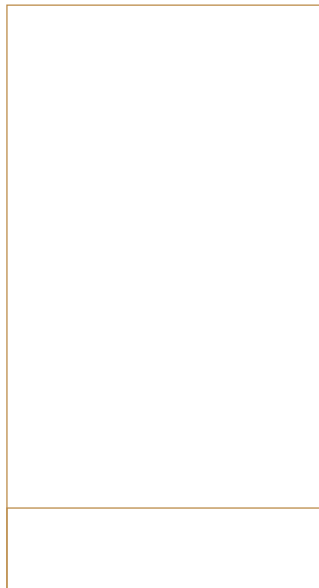
Draw and colour in the things you have chosen and then get a grown up to help you cut them out.

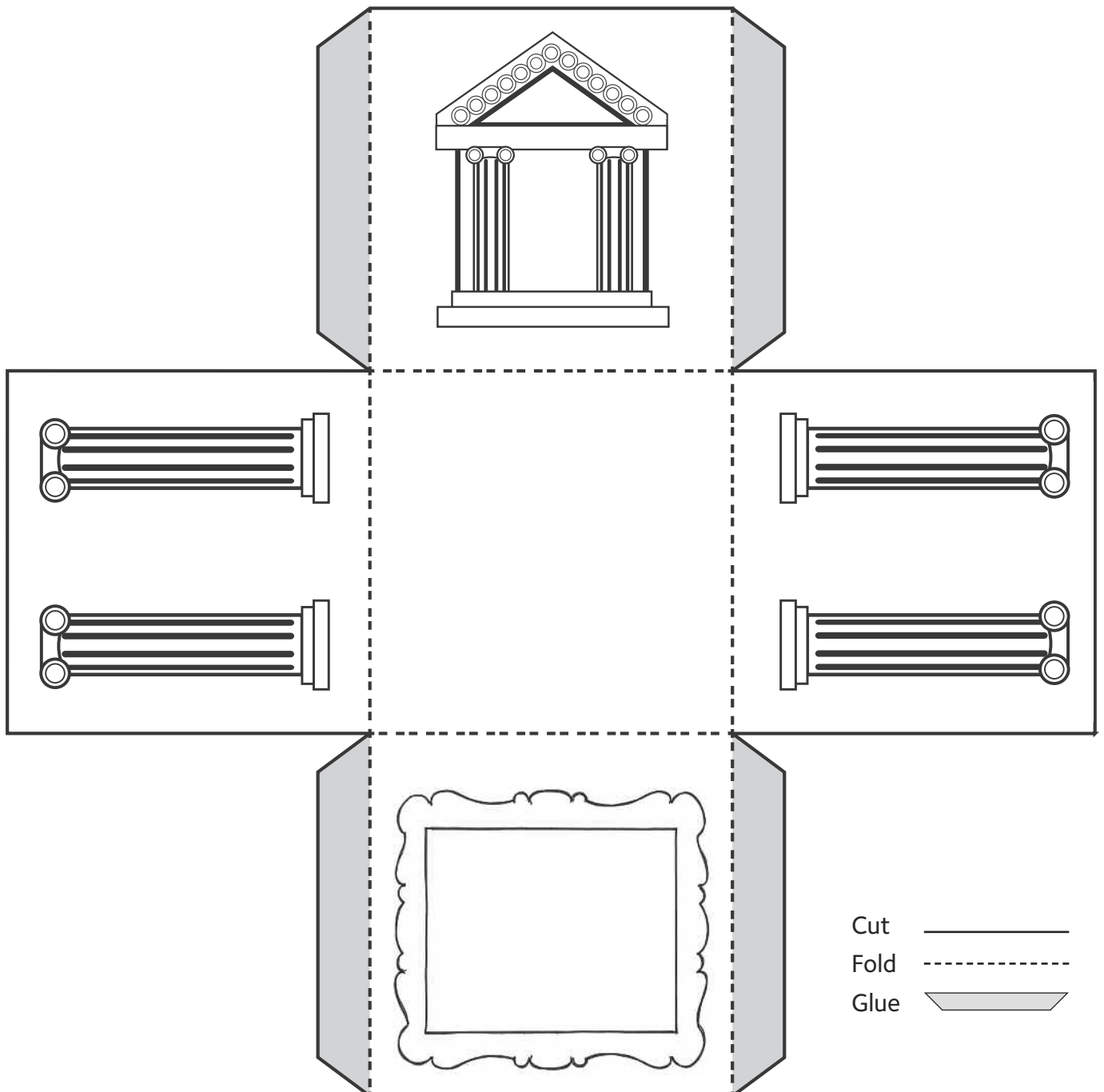
When you have finished choosing your objects look at the next sheet for instructions on how to build your own museum!

- 2 Cut around the outside of the template (you can get a grown up to help you with this)
- 3 Crease along the folds
- 4 Glue the edges
- 5 Stick together (you can always use paper clips to hold the museum in place while it dries)
- 6 Fill your museum full of treasures!
